<b>Boarding &amp; Disembarking</b>	Getting Run Over	1	3	2	Ask passengers along pontoons to be aware of traffic

	Falling between boat and pontoon	1	3	1	Boat to be tied tight to pontoon and use ramp where necessary Crew to supervise and help where possible
<b>Decks</b>	Tripping or slipping	2	3	1	Keep decks clean and tidy at all times

<b>Communication</b>	Radio failure	1	1	1	Handheld as spare, also mobiles

<b>Steering</b>	Steering failure	1	1	1	Throw anchor overboard Connect emergency steering

	Heat contact with stern canvas covers	2	1	1	Canvas covers to be raised when BBQ is in use
	Gas	1	1	1	Shut off valve to be used when not in use
